### **TO ALL PARENTS AND CARERS**

As I am sure you are aware we have all been advised to remain ever vigilant with regard to swine flu. I am writing to reiterate and remind you of our current procedures to minimise the potential spread of infection:-

- If your son has any flu-like symptoms please inform your GP - and naturally respond to their advice and guidance in relation to your son attending school
- If a student attends the medical room with any flu-like symptoms he will be sent home

When your son is in school he must remember to:-

- Always carry tissues
- Use clean tissues to cover the mouth and nose when coughing or sneezing
- Bin the tissues after each use and use a fresh one
- Wash hands regularly with soap and hot water

If a student has been at home unwell and returns to school apparently still unwell, you will be asked to collect him from school and keep him at home until he is completely recovered.

We are very proud of our students' commitment to their education – however, for the health and safety of the whole school community we are very grateful for your support in taking sensible precautions in relation to this matter.
